TERRI LEGRAND ANNOUNCES CAMPAIGN FOR NC SENATE

Kernersville, NC - Terri LeGrand proudly announces her candidacy for North Carolina Senate District 31, which serves Davie County and parts of Forsyth County and the city of Winston-Salem.

“I am running for the NC Senate because I believe we have lost our way,” says LeGrand. “In our state government, divisions are wide, compromise is missing, and moral and ethical behavior is lacking. We need to send legislators to Raleigh who truly want to work together across party lines to provide good jobs, affordable health care, quality and equitable schools, common sense gun safety laws, a clean and sustainable environment - the building blocks for a healthy and vibrant economy.”

Terri LeGrand grew up in a small mountain community. She earned her Juris Doctor degree from Wake Forest University School of Law and a Bachelor of Science degree from Iowa State University. Terri LeGrand will formally file for the NC Senate District 31 race on Monday, December 2 at noon at the Forsyth County Board of Elections, 201 N Chestnut St. in Winston-Salem. She will hold a press conference immediately after filing and is available for interviews.
